

3.e. SOCIAL COMPETITIONS: "Play & Win" Weekend.

Place:

South /North course.

Dates:

They will be announced in due course as far in advance as possible. Always on weekends or holidays when no other club competition open to members is held.

Participants:

All members and their guests, both amateurs and professionals, of any nationality, may participate, as long as they are in possession of the corresponding federation licence in force by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation.

The maximum handicap will be 36 for men and ladies.

The maximum number of participants will be 92, in case of exceeding it, the limitation will be established by order of registration.

The Committee reserves the possibility of varying the number of participants if it considers it appropriate for the convenience of the competition.

NOTE:

Juniors members of the RCG Guadalmina school will not be able to participate in the Saturday competitions except on days when there are no classes.

Categories:

A category will be established for every 20 adult amateur participants, distributing the surplus among the existing categories proportionally upwards to complete a new category, starting with the highest category. If there are too many players with the same handicap, the competition committee may modify the number of participants in each category.

Junior players will have their own category, being necessary to qualify for a prize at least 10 participants, in which case the distribution will be in the same proportions as the rest of the categories.

The participation of professional players will be subject to the same criteria as the junior players.

In the pair events, a category will be established for every 20 sides, with equal distribution of the surplus registered players who do not complete the category, in the case of senior Amateur players.

In the case of Professionals or Juniors in pair or team competitions, there will also be single categories, the pairs or teams being made up of players of the same category.

Registrations: Registrations should be made on the website or at Clapphouse

Registration Fees:

The registration fee is €5 for all junior and senior amateur and professional players.

Players will also pay the corresponding green fee according to their status as a member or guest.

Once the playing schedules have been published, cancellations or no-shows will be subject to the stipulations of the regulations in this section.

Tee Box:

It will be possible to start from early bars, provided that sufficient notice is given at the Caddy Master in advance so that the card is printed with the corresponding handicap.

Gameplay:

Attempts shall be made to play in handicap-valid modes.

Unless expressly stated otherwise, they shall be stipulated rounds of 18 holes in the usual order of the holes. In Scramble competitions, the handicap is adjusted as recommended in appendix C of the handicap system. Scramble 4 players: 25%, 20%, 15%, 10% of the handicap from the lowest to the highest.

Scramble 2 players: 35% lower and 15% higher.

The team may not play with a handicap higher than the lowest handicap of the players making up the team unless otherwise specified in the rules of the event.

- The ball (in scramble mode) is placed in the fairway, rough, bunker and penalty area (measured from the relief area, one card), no closer to the hole and in the same area of the course as the resting place of the chosen ball,

Order, starting time and card collection:

As set by the Committee for each event, which will be announced on clapphouse and the website.

At present you can choose a timetable on the app when booking.

If the start is at the shotgun start, the collection of cards will preferably be the day before in order not to collapse the caddy-master on the morning of the race.

Prizes:

Junior players will receive 80% of the proceeds corresponding to their category, with the top four players receiving 40%, 30%, 20% and 10% of the resulting amount.

Professional players will also have the same distribution.

For the rest of the senior players the distribution of the inscription will be in the same way, proportional between the resulting categories, that is to say, if there were 3 categories, 80% of the amount collected among all these players will be distributed among the 3 categories and this third will in turn be distributed among the first 4 classified handicap from the best classified to the worst, according to the established percentages of 40%, 30%, 20% and 10%. Non-members will not be eligible for a prize.

In the pair or team events, the percentages assigned are for the pair or team.

The results of each event will be published on the website and in the application on the same day of the event for possible claims.

Rules of Play:

The game will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf in force at the RFEG and the Club's Local Rules.

Card delivery:

Cards must be delivered to the Caddy Master's office without delay.

A card is considered to have been delivered when players have left the Caddy Master's office.

In the subscribers:

Any member or guest not registered in the Championship may play the same if there are available spaces and under the same conditions as the rest of the participants.

Several:

Buggies are permitted. In all matters not expressly stated in these rules, the club's competition book shall apply. The Competition Committee will be formed by the Club's own Competition Committee, assisted by the Caddy

Master on duty. In order to be awarded with a handicap prize, or to qualify in a handicap category, Players must provide with 4 valid results obtained during the previous 12 months to the celebration of the prize giving ceremony. To this effect, valid results is what has been defined in World Handicap System (WHS).

. In everything that is not expressly stated in this regulation, it will be as indicated in the competition booklet.
