



Due to the work carried out on the second part of the NORTH course (holes 10 to 18), there are some easily recognizable areas in the General Area that show surface damage, such as machinery tracks, trench damage, etc.

All these areas within the General Area have been defined by the Committee as GROUND UNDER REPAIR. Therefore, if this condition interferes (with the lie of the ball, the intended stance area, or the intended swing area), the player may take relief without penalty, in accordance with Rule 16.1b, by dropping the original ball or another ball in the following relief area:

- **Reference point:** The nearest point of complete relief in the General Area.
- **Size of the relief area measured from the reference point:** One club-length, with the following limitations: It must be in the General Area, it must not be closer to the hole than the reference point, it must provide complete relief from the interference caused by the Ground Under Repair.
