

Course Committee report

The end of 2016 were the worst floods that recalls. North course was affected greatly and had to work in order to recover for the game this tour, especially with regard to bridges OVER THE Chopo River.



This forced us to work cleaning and besides the reconstruction of four bridges, we were immersed in the reconstruction of the bunkers of the South course, from scratch including drainage all the way until the addition of the necessary sand.

In total we have refurbished 32 bunkers out of 61 in the south course And we have added sand to the North course as well

We also introduced a program of pruning and removal of trees and removal of stumps of older trees in total we have removed more than 200 trees and took away about 80 stumps.

Over seeding both courses with RYE GRASS , because of the drought of last months, the driest in 25 years, the germination has been quite slow field South, just to remind you that our courses are mainly worm temperature grass like BERMUDA, which pales in winter



We have painted white lines of in the field North tunnel



We should also highlight the construction TEES of hole 14 2ND and 10TH on the South Courses or the installation of a new toilet by the 11th hole North Course.

We would like to remark the we have also installed railing on the bridges and extended buggy concrete paths in both courses

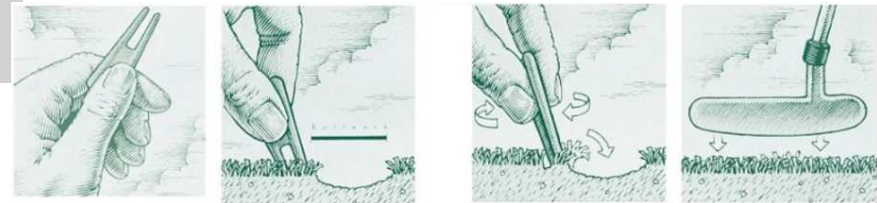

We launched the sand bags program through a bag system and with sand bottles in the electric trolleys and buggies, and we developed a program to encourage members to repair divots by handing over pitch forks for members, with a campaign of how to fix the marks on the greens.

For 2018, we plan to continue with our **tees reconstruction program** mainly in the North course, and we will continue with the removal of dead tress and stumps program and replanting of trees

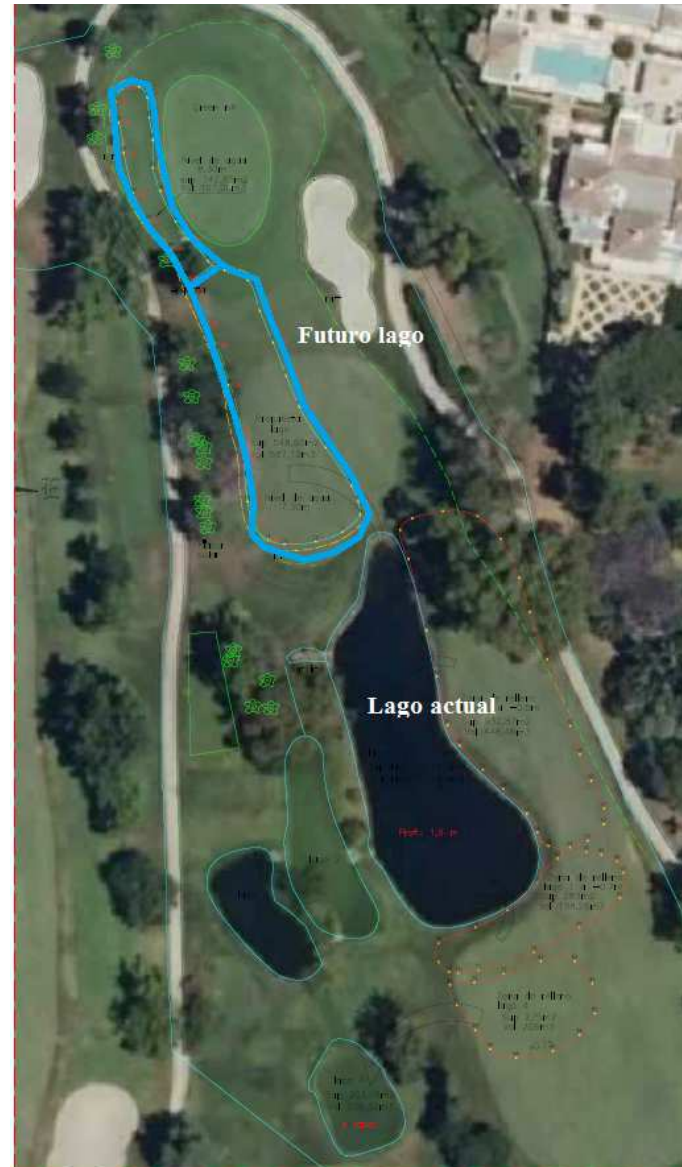

Distance form that point the edge of the green 51 meters



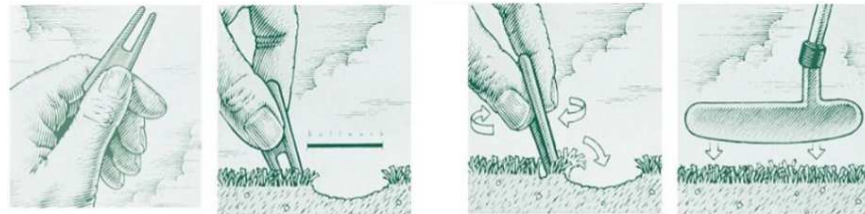
Likewise we will proceed with the expansion of the practice area at the end of the DRIVING RANGE . Allowing players to enjoy an alternative practice area, this includes
